This wine is intensely aromatic, with perfumes of boysenberry, asparagus and freshly cut herbs.

The palate shows the classic herbaceous characters of cut grass and green beans for which Marlborough is renowned and offers a fresh clean finish.

Cooking

This wine is well suited to Asian foods, spicy baked fish and fresh barbecued seafood –a favourite match of ours is Thai prawn, beansprout and carrot salad (see our website for recipe).
