Tasting Note

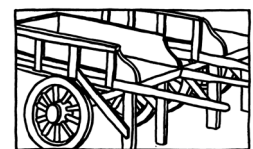
The Handcart Shiraz is made from premium cool climate fruit sourced from our Western Branch vineyard. This vibrant Shiraz is bursting with luscious ripe blackberry and plum aromas underpinned by subtle cassia characters. The palate has a savoury note, showing white pepper spice with well-balanced tannins delivering a dry finish.

This wine embodies all the things we love about young, cool climate Shiraz. Just like the welcome company of a good friend, the generosity of fruit flavours balanced against fragrant spice and tannins will have you returning to The Handcart time and time again.
